 - Always wear my closed-toed shoes
 - Wear a properly fitted USCG approved lifejacket when on, in or near the water
 - Stay within sight and sound of my Instructors and Naturalists and never go anywhere alone or without permission
 - Follow all instructions given by all WFC staff
 - Never throw rocks or sand, or engage in horseplay of any kind

- **Be RESPECTFUL!**
 - Always listen to Instructors and Naturalists
 - Take good care of equipment, marine life and the natural environment
 - Cooperate, be a good team-player and help keep it positive and fun
 - Keep it neat and clean- put all garbage and recycling where it belongs
 - Respect myself and peers- I will not bully, tease use foul and/or inappropriate language, and keep my hands and feet to myself

 - Participate in activities
 - Have a positive attitude
 - Leave all electronics and valuables at home (cellphones, video games, jewelry, etc.) If I need to call home, I will use a WFC phone.
